Mike and Jo Roche

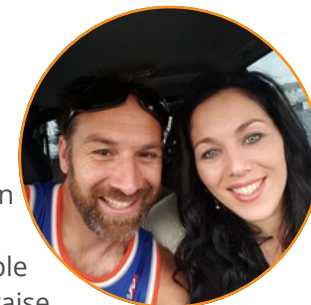
